

# Monthly Highlights

Throughout 2025, each month brought new opportunities to see God move in powerful ways. From moments of prayer and worship to outreach, discipleship, and celebration, these highlights capture how God did more than we could ask or imagine—through our church family, our city, and beyond.

## January

We began the year seeking God together through 21 Days of Fasting & Prayer, uniting our church in daily prayer, Scripture, and expectation. As we intentionally put God first, thousands engaged through in-person gatherings and the Bible App, with over 850 participants completing reading plans and prayer moments together.

## February

February was a celebration of the people who make ministry happen. At Team Night, we honored and encouraged Westover's 1,000+ Dream Teamers—faithful servants who give their time and talents to build God's Kingdom week after week. Later in the month, Elevate Men's Night gathered 850 men for worship and community, strengthening brotherhood across our church.

## March

Women from across our church and city gathered for Thrive, with 1,300 ladies in attendance. Led by guest speaker Melissa Alfaro, the night was marked by powerful worship, encouragement, and a renewed call for women to walk boldly in their God-given purpose.



## April

April was filled with celebration and new life. Our first-ever Easter Fiesta welcomed 3,400 people to a community-wide event designed to share the story of Jesus and the hope of the cross. Easter weekend followed with 8,200 people attending services, as we celebrated the resurrection of Jesus and the hope it brings to every generation.

## May

Through Kingdom Builders and our ongoing school partnerships, we honored and served local educators during Teacher Appreciation initiatives. These moments reminded teachers they are seen, valued, and supported, while strengthening relationships with schools across our city.

## June

Momentum Student Conference gathered 485 students for a life-changing experience centered on worship, truth, and identity in Christ. The impact was eternal. 70 students made decisions to follow Jesus, marking a powerful move of God in the next generation.



## August

As summer ended, we returned to prayer through another season of 21 Days of Fasting & Prayer, realigning our hearts with God's direction. At the same time, Back to School Drives and school partnerships helped provide essential supplies and support for students and families as they prepared for a new school year.



## September

Elevate Men's Night continued to grow, bringing together 900 men! In the same month, Westover participated in One Day to Feed the World, giving generously to help provide food, clean water, and hope to children and families around the globe.


## October

October marked a milestone for Westover Sports, hosting the largest youth soccer league in our church's history. With over 600 athletes participating, families were connected to community, mentorship, and the love of Christ through sports.



## November

Thrive returned in November with 1,000 ladies gathering for another powerful night. The event continues to create space for women to be refreshed, encouraged, and empowered in their faith.



## December

2025 concluded with our Field of Lights outreach, welcoming a record-high attendance of over 35,000 people. This event helped us share the love of Jesus and the hope of Christmas with families throughout the season, resulting in 39 people giving their lives to Christ on the field!


